High-quality Development of Think Tanks with Chinese Characteristics: Problems and Suggestions

Abstract

Nowadays think tanks in China largely face the problems of "pace" and "adaptation". Typically, vision, capacity and idea of think tank research can hardly meet the policy-making demand. Also, management, expression and evaluation systems can rarely adapt to the functions of think tanks. This research suggests that, in order to promote the high-quality development of think tanks with Chinese characteristics, the emphases should be on the constructions of the institutional environment, the innovation ability, the "opening-up" concept, and the international collaborations.
